PILLOWCASE



Materials needed:

3/4 yard for body 1/3 yard for border Pre-wash your fabric.

Cut your fabric:

Body: 27" x width of the fabric Border: 11" x width of the fabric

With top raw edges even lay out the border fabric RIGHT SIDE UP. Place the body fabric RIGHT SIDE UP on top.



Starting at the bottom, roll the body fabric up untl you can fold up the bottom edge of the border to meet top raw edges of the border and body fabric. Pin. You now have the border encasing the body fabric in a rolled up "burrito."





Stitch across the raw edges in a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam being careful not to catch the roll of body fabric in the seam.

Now you have a tube that is open at both ends.





Turn the tube right side out and unroll the body fabric. Press both sides of the border.





To finish with French seams, place WRONG sides together and stitch the side and bottom in a ¼" seam. Trim the seam close to the stitching. Now place RIGHT sides together and pin. Stitch in a ¼" seam.





Now you have beautiful French Seams and you're all done! Enjoy!
